

## DISPERSAL SALE - BURNWELL FARM, DUNSFORD, EXETER

### Held on Saturday 1st July 2017

Hearde RPS were very pleased to be in attendance at Burnwell Farm to conduct the Dispersal Sale on behalf of Andrew & Margaret Freeman on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> July. The sale also included the dispersal sale on behalf of Mr & Mrs Ron Barter and outside entries to include a wonderful selection of Collectors Tractors. With fantastic weather conditions and a dearth of sales in the Teign Valley, a massive crowd were in attendance with the crowd being the largest seen so far at a Hearde RPS Sale.

The sale commenced with Mr & Mrs Freemans Dispersal and all items were keenly contested. Their top price was achieved by the David Brown 990 2wd Tractor c/w Lambourn Cab that exceeded expectations, selling at £1,220. Their machinery sold well with the Wheatley Trailer selling at £700 and the Abbey 6' Pasture Topper at £680. The quality Granite Troughs on offer saw a top of price of £520 for a Circular Trough, with collectable items such as Milk Churns selling at £62. A few furniture items also met with a pleasing trade peaking at £70 for a Hall Table.

The sale then moved onto the Dispersal on behalf of Mr & Mrs Ron Barter which saw a good line up of Farm Machinery and Effects offered for sale. The days' top machinery price was achieved by Mr & Mrs Barter when they sold their 2013 Teagle Tomahawk 8500 Bale Chopper at £7,600. Other leading prices from Mr & Mrs Barter were as follows:
